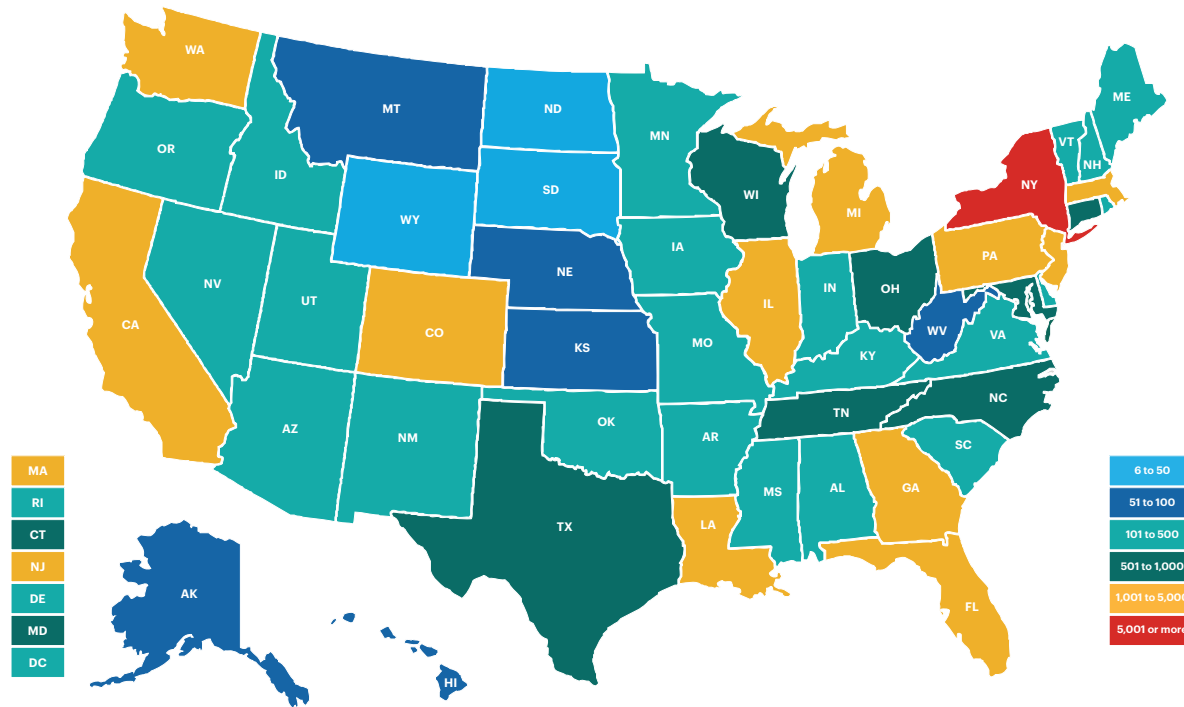


# Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) in the US
