

Below is a summary of the education-related provisions of Governor Reynolds' eighth Emergency Disaster Proclamation compiled by attorneys Tim Coonan and Sydney Gangestad.

<b>High School Equivalency Testing</b>		
Section 35	281 IA Admin Code § 32.7(1)	Suspends provisions that require applicants to retake a high school equivalency degree test if he/she has not earned a high school equivalency degree within 5-years of taking the first subtest; suspension applies during duration of this proclamation
<b>High School Graduation Requirements</b>		
Section 37	Section 256.7(26)(a) and 256.11(5) 281 IA Admin Code § 12.5(5)	Suspends provisions requiring curriculum standards and completion of specific units of credit for completion of a high school program of study, if these provisions would hinder Iowa school districts in assisting the graduating class of 2020 in completing a course of study during this disaster emergency
Section 38	Section 256.11(6)(c) 281 IA Admin Code § 12.5(20)	Suspends provisions requiring each Iowa pupil physically able to do so complete a CPR course to graduate from high school, if these provisions would hinder Iowa school districts in assisting the graduating class of 2020 in completing a course of study during this disaster emergency
